



# Homecoming Court Application

## Application Procedure

A completed application must be submitted to the SGA office (Room 161) or Portable 2 by **October 5, 2017** in order to run for Homecoming Court. Applications received after the due date will not be considered. Potential candidates must have at least a 2.0 GPA and must obtain an administrator's and counselor's signature to ensure the applicant is able to undertake the responsibilities of courtship given their academic and extracurricular schedules. There is a mandatory meeting on **October 6, 2017** in Room 161 during the candidates' lunch period.

In order to promote inclusivity, Blair has decided to allow students to choose their royal title once they are crowned to respect gender and pronoun preferences. Original grade-based names are only available to the grade (ex. King and Queen only available to seniors). The royal titles will be selected upon the candidate's victory.
